

Woy Woy South Public School

Works notification | 23 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

A window was damaged in the boy's toilet in Building L at Woy Woy South Public School. Work to repair it will involve working with known asbestos containing material in the window frame. Following the damage, the window was covered and taped up and the toilet remains safe for occupation.

The window will be repaired on Saturday 1 April 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the toilet is reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
