

Hornsby North Public School

Works notification | 20 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Friday 21 November 2025, we will be removing a demountable building from Hornsby North Public School.

Safety measures will be in place throughout the duration of the works.

Due to the age of the demountable, it is assumed to contain undisturbed asbestos in the window putty. As an extra precaution, the windows will be secured to minimise risk of damage during transportation.

Work is being done under safe work conditions for releasing a building from a school site, which requires a sticker to be attached to the windows of the demountable notifying that the building may contain asbestos during transport.

There is no asbestos removal work being done on the building at the school site or before it is removed.

Closure of Cawthorne Steet Entrance

During the removal, the Cawthorne Steet entrance to Hornsby North Public School will be closed to the school community. Traffic control measures will be put in place to facilitate this closure.

We ask that the community use either the Ida Street or Old Berowra Road Entrances to access the school while the removal is carried out.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We will keep the community updated.
