## Caves Beach Public School Works notification | 2 April 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a recent routine inspection, a broken vinyl tile was identified in a library storeroom at Caves Beach Public School. This tile contains bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

The storeroom was isolated from students and staff. An independent hygienist was engaged to provide advice.

The vinyl tile will be removed outside of school hours on Wednesday 2 April 2025. Clearance will be provided to reopen the room for use.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
