Project Update | December 2023

We are continuing to manage known asbestos in ground at Belair Public School.

We have been working with an independent hygienist to develop a Remediation Action Plan (RAP) and a design consultant to provide design options for remediation work outlined in the RAP.

Following on from our last update (18 September 2023), the independent hygienist has provided recommendations for further soil investigations to support finalising the scope of remediation work and playground design.

Planned work over the Summer school holidays

We will be doing this further investigation work of areas currently fenced off over the upcoming holiday period.

This work will take place during the Summer school holidays. This period may include from the end of **Tuesday 19 December 2023 and will be finished before the first day of students returning on 1 February 2024**

The work involves excavation and soil testing of areas currently fenced off. Air monitoring will continue to be in place during the work.

Work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Following the investigation work, the areas will be inspected to ensure control measures in place are appropriate before Term 1 starts.

We will keep the community updated on next steps for work at the school following results received from this work and finalisation of the scope of work for further remediation.
