Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are pleased to advise we are replacing the carpet in 2 classrooms in Building A and 2 support unit classrooms in Building J at Irrawang Public School.

To prepare for this, we first need to remove vinyl tiles with known bonded asbestos containing material (ACM) located under the existing carpet, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove the vinyl tiles have been scheduled between 3:30 pm Friday 1 May and 5 pm Sunday 3 May 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will be done outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE, air monitoring, and temporary fencing in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's School Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
