

# Baulkham Hills North Public School

## Works notification | 18 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 16 December 2025, during maintenance in an area below the toilets in Building N, material suspected to contain asbestos was found at Baulkham Hills North Public School.

The affected area, while already isolated due to its location, was immediately closed. As a precaution, an independent hygienist was engaged to collect the fragments for testing and provide advice. Testing confirmed that the fragments contained bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”. This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

On Wednesday 17 December 2025, all asbestos-containing materials will be removed under the guidance of an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place.

All asbestos-related work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
