Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

To ensure the safety of our students, staff and community, we are installing a new security system and perimeter fencing at Baulkham Hills North Public School.

This work is scheduled to begin on 14 August 2024 and is expected to take up to 6 weeks.

Excavation work and the use of power tools will create increased noise during construction, between the hours of 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. No construction will take place on Sundays.

Access to school gates will also be temporarily changed. Work will be completed in stages to minimise disruption to school pick-up and drop-off.

Gates along Shepherd Lane, Henry Street, and to the western carpark on Girralong Avenue will be closed intermittently during the first stage (Stage 1), between 14 August 2024 and 5 September 2024.

All other gates along Girralong Avenue, and Parraweena Reserve will be closed intermittently during Stage 2, between 6 – 27 September 2024.

Please use alternative gates if your usual access gate is affected.

When complete, the current fencing will be replaced by a 2.1 metre-high tubular steel security fence and 2 new electronic gates.
