Works notification | 11 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Monday 2 March 2026, a cracked window was identified in a classroom in Building D at Floraville Public School.

The putty material in this window is known to contain bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

The glass was temporarily secured and access to the classroom was immediately restricted.

Work to repair the window took place on Saturday 7 March 2026. Afterwards, an independent hygienist inspected the area and provided clearance for the classroom to be reopened.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors.
