

Jasper Road Public School

Works notification | 16 December 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Damage was identified and reported on an external eave where a light fitting came loose outside of the Support Unit building (Building B) at Jasper Road Public School. Material in the external eave of the building is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

The external area was cordoned off from students and staff and an independent hygienist was engaged to undertake air monitoring and provide advice.

Work to repair the eave sheeting is planned to take place on Thursday 19 December 2024 on a school development day.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place within the school's vacation care hours with safety measures in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

After repairs, the area will be inspected by the independent hygienist and clearance will be provided to reopen the area for use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
