

# Mount Warrigal Public School

## Works notification | 9 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are upgrading a kitchenette next to a classroom in Building H at Mount Warrigal Public School.

The upgrades include:

- new flooring
- new cabinetry
- new sink.

Access to the kitchenette room will be restricted until upgrades are finished, mid-2025.

As part of this work, we will be removing bonded asbestos from within the vinyl floor tiles. This work will take place outside school hours on Saturday 10 May 2025.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the rest of the upgrade continues.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
