

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During routine inspections undertaken between 14–23 May, mould was detected at Wyoming Public School:

- on the carpet in the counsellor's office in Building A
- on the ceiling in the student toilets in Building C
- a storage cupboard located in a hallway in Building C
- a classroom storeroom in Building C.

Following the inspection the toilets, storeroom and cupboard in Building C and the counsellor's office in Building A were immediately isolated from students and staff.

Between 15–26 May 2024, a specialist cleaning contractor was engaged to undertake an environmental clean of the storeroom, cupboard and counsellor's office and remove any impacted materials. These areas remained isolated until the remediation could be completed. A classroom was closed during these remediation works. Following this remediation these areas were inspected and cleared to be reopened for use.

On 24 May 2024 an independent hygienist attended the school to conduct testing and provide advice on remediation works for the toilets.

Following the work, an independent hygienist will inspect the toilets to ensure all affected areas have been fully remediated. The school will also receive a clearance certificate before the toilets are reopened for use.

All inspections and remediation works have been conducted in accordance with recommendations from the independent hygienist.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority.
