Works notification | 11 February 2026


Dear staff, neighbours, parents and carers,

We are installing 2 new light towers at the south end of the oval of St Ives Park Public School.

The new lights will be used to enable nighttime training on the oval for local community AFL teams.

The installation will take up to 2 weeks and the area near the work will be out of bounds to students and staff while work is completed.

The timeline below identifies the schedule of work, beginning on Tuesday 17 February 2026.



The expected completion date is weather permitting.

What to expect

During the works, there may be some construction noise as there will be heavy machinery, including cranes, concrete trucks and delivery vehicles accessing the school. As such, some noise and disruption can be expected throughout the construction period.

During this time, there will be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements in nearby streets. Contractors will access the site through the Woodbury Road entrance.

Contractors will have noise and dust mitigation measures in place and will monitor noise levels throughout the work period. Noisy works will be conducted outside of school hours as much as possible to minimise any disruption to the school and surrounding community.

Work hours

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturday, in line with [NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines](#).
