Works notification | 10 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are upgrading 16 toilets across Buildings G, H, and I at Murray Farm Public School.

As part of this upgrade, we have to work with suspected asbestos containing material in toilet partitions in 2 toilets in Building I. Work to remove these toilet partitions is planned to take place on Saturday 19 August 2023.

The toilets are being safely used as the partitions are undisturbed. The toilets will be cordoned off before the work starts.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The toilets will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm the asbestos containing material has been fully removed, and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before the upgrade work continues.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
