Project overview

In December 2020, construction began to deliver a new library and an upgraded administration building at Lapstone Public School as part of the Department of Education's Upgrades and Addition program.

The new open-plan library includes a reception area, accessible bathroom, storage and shared office facilities, as well as adjoining learning spaces.

The upgraded administration building includes office facilities for staff, bathroom and sick bay facilities, a staff room, plus a meeting and interview room.
