

Killarney Vale Public School

Community update | November 2024

Dear parents, carers and staff,

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024–25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades.

As part of this investment, Killarney Vale Public School will receive a share for electrical upgrades.

These electrical upgrades will further enhance safety and accommodate future technology needs.

The project includes:

- design of upgraded power supply, enabling adequate electrical supply for the school's future needs
- staged works, with Stage 1 involving an upgrade of existing distribution boards across the school. These boards distribute power from the main supply to different circuits and outlets.

A contractor has been engaged and their report will inform the scope of works.

Stage 1 is expected to start in March 2025 and finish June 2025, weather and other conditions permitting.
