As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Killarney Vale Public School is receiving electrical upgrades as part of this investment.

We are pleased to advise that the upgrade of the power supply and electrical distribution boards is running on schedule.

This work will accommodate future and increased technology needs.

Next steps

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

We will be working at your school during the Winter School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 4 July 2025 up to Day 1 Term 3 (Tuesday 22 July 2025).

To finish the electrical upgrade, there will be power outages in the winter holidays, while students and staff are not at the school.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

The electrical upgrade is expected to be finished by Day 1 Term 3, 2025.
