

Killarney Vale Public School

Works notification | 17 February 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Following a vandalism incident on Wednesday 15 February, we are repairing damage to a wall in Building C at Killarney Vale Public School. The repairs involve working with asbestos containing material in the wall panel. The damaged wall was immediately boarded up and the area cordoned off and isolated.

An independent hygienist was engaged and work to remove the material started on Wednesday 15 February out of school hours. Works are expected to be finished by Friday 17 February 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will continue to take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place including air monitoring.

The area will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
