Works notification | 9 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Following a vandalism incident, upcoming maintenance works to repair damage to the hallway ceiling in Building B at Wideview Public School will involve working with asbestos containing material. The area is currently cordoned off with temporary fencing, and the holes in the ceiling have been made safe and the asbestos containing material was encapsulated.

Work to remove the material and repair the ceiling will take place between Thursday 9 March and Monday 13 March 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

The area will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
