

Wollondilly Public School

Works notification | 19 February 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

On Monday 9 February 2026 during severe storms, water came into the meeting room and adjoining office of the administration building at Wollondilly Public School. The cause of the water coming into the building is currently being investigated.

The areas have already been cordoned off with access restricted to students and staff.

Remediation works to replace the carpet, and flooring began on Tuesday 10 February 2026 and will take place between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm. The flooring under the carpet in the meeting room and office are known to contain bonded asbestos as per the School's Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

During these works, mould was identified underneath the carpet, and cleaning is now underway.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

NSW Health advises mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast. Further information can be found on the [NSW Health mould factsheet](#).

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance before the rooms are reopened for use.

All work involving mould and other hazardous materials will take place outside of school hours, with appropriate safety measures in place. Use and access to the 2 rooms will be restricted until the areas are fully remediated.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
