

# Crestwood Public School

## Works notification | 18 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Friday 13 February 2026, during a routine safety inspection, sheeting materials were found suspected to contain asbestos in the underfloor storage of Building F at Crestwood Public School.

This area was not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

The sheets were in good condition, and the area was already inaccessible to students and staff.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

On Sunday 22 March 2026, all suspected asbestos-containing materials will be removed under the guidance of an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate before the area is reopened. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place.

All asbestos-related work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
