Works notification | 20 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We would like to advise you of work to replace damaged flooring in the bag room in Building E at Crestwood Public School.

As part of this work, old vinyl tiles under the existing flooring will need to be removed and the tiles on top replaced.

The old vinyl tiles are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos management plan (SAMP). We have laid rubber matting and the existing covering back over them in advance of the removal work.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

On Tuesday 24 March 2026, all asbestos-containing materials will be removed outside of school hours, contractor availability and weather permitting.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws as well as the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists who will provide clearance before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
