

Crestwood Public School

Works notification | 25 July 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a routine inspection on Wednesday 23 July 2025, we identified ceiling panels in 2 demountable classrooms requiring repairs at Crestwood Public School. The ceilings in these demountable classrooms are listed as containing bonded asbestos on the school asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

One demountable classroom was not being used by the school, and the other was being used as a music classroom.

As a precaution, both demountable classrooms were isolated from students and staff, and the music class has been moved to an alternative classroom at the school.

We are currently working on scheduling the complete removal of the older style demountable classrooms at the school. This work will be conducted outside of school hours in coming weeks.

We will continue to keep the community updated on these demountable removal works once dates are confirmed.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
