We are pleased to let you know about Improvements to the cricket nets and pitch at Hobartville Public School.

Starting in the autumn school holidays, we will begin work on replacing the cricket nets and resurfacing the cricket pitch. We expect work to be finished by the end of Term 2, 2026, site conditions and weather permitting.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.
