Works notification | 29 August 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will be removing bonded asbestos from the external eaves of Building D on Saturday 30 August 2025 at Guise Public School.

The eaves require remediation as part of the removal of bird nests, which have been identified as not being protected species, inside the roof cavity of Building D.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The damaged eaves and bird nests will be removed, with the ceiling cavity then sealed with gyprock to prevent nesting in the future.

As the eaves are outdoors and unable to be accessed by students and staff the area is not cordoned off.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The roof cavity will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
