Works notification | 20 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Department of Education is undertaking planned maintenance works at King Park Public School.

On Saturday 21 February 2026, we will be removing vinyl floor tiles in the year 4 classroom in Building C to allow for the replacement of carpet tiles.

The vinyl floor tiles are known to contain bonded asbestos as per the School's Asbestos Management Plan. As a precaution, the classroom has been locked from students and staff access, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the rooms are reopened.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

An independent hygienist will inspect the classroom, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
