Works notification | 27 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

A staff member found a damaged partition door on Tuesday 17 March 2026 in the Building C girls toilets at King Park Public School.

As a precaution the toilet was locked to staff and students as the partition and door are known to contain bonded asbestos as per the Schools Asbestos Management Plan.

An independent hygienist completed testing and an inspection of the toilets on Tuesday 24 March 2026.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials and repair the partition will take place on Saturday 28 March 2026.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures in place. Work hours are between 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued before the toilets are reopened.
