Works notification | 2 April 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the [works notification issued on 28 March 2025](#) (see below), remediation of asbestos-containing vinyl tiles located in a Building D classroom at King Park Public School will take place on Saturday 5 April 2025.

The vinyl floor tiles and cabinetry baseboards will be removed by licensed asbestos contractors and covered with new, replacement cabinets.

Work will take place outside of school hours with safety measures in place, including air monitoring.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health, and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The classroom will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

Works notification: 28 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Pieces of vinyl tile assumed to contain bonded asbestos have been found by staff under a cabinet, in a classroom of Building D, at King Park Public School on 25 March 2025.

As the vinyl is listed in the school's asbestos register, the room was immediately locked to restrict access, and students have been relocated to the library for their learning.

Testing completed by an independent hygienist the same day (25 March) confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The classroom will remain closed until remediation work is completed and a clearance certificate is provided by the independent hygienist.

We will update the community when this work has been scheduled.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
