Dear staff, parents and carers,

Planned maintenance work is underway to refurbish the girls' toilet block in Building D at John Warby Public School.

Refurbishment work will include:

- replacing toilet partition walls and doors
- floor and wall tile replacement
- painting and lighting upgrades
- new toilet cisterns, sinks, taps and related items.

Work is expected to be completed Week 1 Term 2.

Construction will begin on Saturday 5 April with the removal of the toilet partitions, which are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed in the school's asbestos register.

The partitions are currently undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Safety measures, including temporary fencing and air monitoring, will also be in place.


Work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Construction will continue after a clearance certificate has been issued by the hygienist, confirming the area has been fully remediated.
