

# Cambridge Gardens Public School

## Works notification | 16 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the Summer School Holidays, material suspected to contain asbestos was found in the storeroom in the hall of Building D at Cambridge Gardens Public School. The storeroom was locked and the affected area was immediately isolated.

As a precaution, an independent hygienist was engaged to collect the fragments for testing and provide advice. Test results confirmed that the fragments contained bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

On Thursday 29 January 2026, all asbestos-containing materials were removed under the guidance of an independent hygienist who issued a clearance certificate.

All asbestos-related work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
