

Cambridge Gardens Public School

Works notification | 21 August 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a routine inspection, a fragment of material suspected to contain asbestos was found in a grassed area near Building E at the southern end of Cambridge Gardens Public School.

The area was isolated from students and staff, the material was removed, and an independent hygienist was engaged to undertake testing and provide advice.

Test results confirmed that the fragment contained bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The hygienist inspected the area on Friday 15 August and cleared the area to be reopened.

The location where the fragment was found was not in the school's asbestos register, which has been updated to include this recent find.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
