

Singleton Heights Public School

Works notification | 30 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our planned maintenance work, we repaired external brickwork near 2 windows on the Administration Building at Singleton Heights Public School.

This work included removing and replacing bricks that sit alongside 2 external window frames that are sealed in place with material assumed to contain bonded asbestos. The existing sealant was undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Repair and removal work took place on Saturday 31 May 2025.

Safety measures including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during the work.

Following the work the areas were inspected by an independent hygienist and clearance was provided.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
