

Hampden Park Public School

Works notification | 22 April 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We wish to advise that we are installing secure access gates in the laneway connecting Wangee Road and Hampden Road at Hampden Park Public School.

This laneway is on land owned by the NSW Department of Education and provides a pedestrian access point for staff and students entering and exiting Hampden Park Public School.

The NSW Department of Education can fence off school properties as indicated in the [Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 \(ILP Act\)](#). Hampden Park Public School is “inclosed land” for the purposes of the ILP Act.

The gates will be installed at the access points on Wangee Road and Hampden Road. By installing the gates and restricting access to the laneway, we will be providing greater security for our students, staff and the wider community.

The gates will be opened by school staff each school day at drop off and pick up times. Outside of these times, the gates will be locked.

We understand that securing the laneway will remove a pedestrian access path between Wangee Road and Hampden Road. We have consulted with Canterbury-Bankstown Council as part of this work.
