Works notification | 3 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers, and neighbours,

We are removing a demountable building currently located on the southern side, near Blackwood Avenue, at Dulwich Hill Public School.

Removal will take place on **Friday 26 September 2025**.

Due to the age of the demountable, it is assumed to contain undisturbed asbestos in the window putty. As an extra precaution, the windows will be secured to minimise risk of damage during transportation.

The work is being done under safe work conditions for releasing a building from a school site, which requires a sticker to be attached to the windows of the demountable notifying that the building may contain asbestos during transport.

There is no asbestos removal work being done on the building at the school site or before it is removed.

Work hours, access and traffic

A mobile crane will be delivered at 5:30 am to lift the demountable in sections onto the truck.

Work to remove the demountable will be done between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm and is expected to be finished in one day, weather and site conditions permitting.

Access to the school, school carpark and main entrance will not be affected.

Work vehicles will enter and exit the school site via Blackwood Avenue and the demountable will be temporarily fenced off within a construction zone during the removal.

All work will take place within the school grounds and will be coordinated with the school to avoid any disruption to learning.

Please follow the directions of any temporary signage when in place.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
