Works update | 20 May 2024

Dear staff, parents/carers,

We are writing to provide an update about the roof works that have been taking place at Toormina Public School this year.

As we notified on [6 March 2024](#), this work has involved working with lead-containing dust and asbestos containing material.

Work is being completed in stages to minimise impacts on learning and teaching. Work is scheduled to continue throughout Term 2, with buildings continuing to be cordoned off and out of bounds to students and staff until the work is complete.

Completed work

Works in Buildings F, C and B have been completed.

Each of these buildings has been inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school received clearance certificates before the buildings were reopened.

Further work

Building E's scheduled work is underway and completion is expected by the end of May 2024, weather permitting.

Remediation of this material is scheduled to take place over the weekend of Saturday 25 May and Sunday 26 May.

All work is being done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work is being completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Building E will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the building is reopened.
