Works notification | 9 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are writing to inform you about a significant project underway at the neighbouring Toormina High School, and what it will mean for Toormina Public School.

About the project

In 2021, Toormina High School sustained damage to buildings during a significant hailstorm. Following the completion of insurance assessment and planning, a full roof replacement will commence later this year.

Work will include:

- replacement of roofs across all buildings
- full interior reinstatement of each building, including new ceilings, carpet, lighting, and replacement of affected joinery
- installation of new stormwater infrastructure throughout the high school.

There is no construction work taking place at Toormina Public School. This notification is to keep you informed about the activity next door and to explain one area where the two schools will work together during the project.

What is happening and when

Site preparation at Toormina High School is already underway, with fencing being installed on the high school oval this week.

More than 20 demountable classrooms will be placed on the high school oval from late March 2026 to provide temporary teaching and learning spaces when construction starts.

Construction on the school buildings is expected to begin in Term 3 2026, with the project expected to be complete by mid-2028, subject to contract finalisation, weather and site conditions.

Use of Toormina Public School's oval

While demountables occupy their oval, Toormina High School students will make use of Toormina Public School's oval for sport and recreation.

We are committed to ensuring this arrangement has as little impact as possible on our students. Timetabling will be managed in close coordination with both schools, and any changes to arrangements will be communicated to you in advance.

Managing construction impacts

During the work, including provisioning such as plumbing and electrical works for the demountable installations, there will be construction noise due to the use of heavy machinery. Some noise and traffic disruption may be experienced in the vicinity of the school and neighbouring properties. Working hours will be confirmed once the contract is awarded and will be communicated before works begin. All works will be undertaken in accordance with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.
