Works notification | 24 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Two windows were damaged in a classroom in Building A at Gorokan Public School. Work to repair them will involve working with known asbestos containing material within the window frames.

The windows have been covered in plastic sheeting and because the window frames are undamaged the classroom continues to be suitable for occupation.

The windows will be repaired on Saturday 9 September 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The classroom will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the classroom is reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
