Works notification | 11 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we will be removing and replacing ceiling panels on the outdoor walkway between Building F and the covered outdoor learning area (COLA) at The Grange Public School.

The panels are known to contain bonded asbestos, which is undisturbed, as listed in the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours, on Saturday 15 March 2025.

Safety measures, including monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), will be in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by an independent hygienist.

After repairs are finished, the independent hygienist will inspect and provide a clearance certificate before the area is reopened.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
