Works notification | 24 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

A damaged asbestos-containing ceiling panel located in the covered walkway, between buildings E and F at Glenwood Public School, will be replaced on Saturday 29 March 2025.

The panel, which is listed in the school's asbestos register, was affected by water overflow from a blocked gutter and encapsulated by licensed contractors during the summer school holidays.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Removal of the asbestos containing material, and installation of a new ceiling panel, will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors, and monitored by independent hygienists.

Safety measures, including air monitoring and temporary fencing, will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The ceiling will be inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued to confirm it has been fully remediated.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
