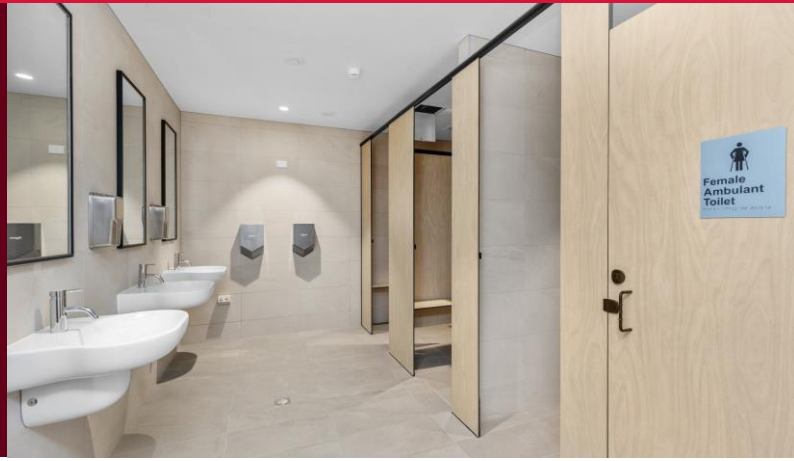


St Clair Public School Project update | March 2025



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment, St Clair Public School will receive a refurbishment of the bathrooms in the school hall.

This project includes upgrading the facilities by removing and replacing the toilet partitions, floor tiles, toilets, sinks and soap dispensers.

Replacing the toilet partitions will involve removing the existing partitions known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Work will start on Friday 21 March 2025 and is scheduled to be finished by Day 1 Term 2 2025. Most of the work will take place during the Autumn School Holidays.

The partitions will be removed on Saturday 22 March when students and staff are not on site.

Once the partitions have been removed, an independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate and the remaining work will continue.
