Works notification | 6 November 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

We are refurbishing the student toilets in Building J at St Clair Public School.

To prepare for this work, we are removing the partition walls of the toilet cubicles which contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos management plan.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The asbestos removal work is planned for Saturday 15 November 2025.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place during this work. All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

Alternative toilets are available at the school during the toilet refurbishment, which is expected to be finished by early 2026.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
