

Blairmount Public School

Works notification | 5 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the Summer School Holidays Blairmount Public School received a large amount of rain during a storm on the weekend of Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 January 2026.

Rain entered a classroom storeroom in Building C through the roof. During repair work due to water damage, the contractor identified possible mould in the storeroom on Monday 19 January 2026.

A cleaning contractor began an environmental clean of the storeroom on Tuesday 20 January 2026. All remediation and cleaning was completed on Wednesday 4 February 2026.

As a precaution, the storeroom and classroom were both closed when school returned on Day 1 Term 1 2026, and no staff or students were able to access them.

An independent hygienist completed air monitoring and testing during and after cleaning.

All work involving mould took place with appropriate safety measures in place. The hygienist provided a clearance certificate on Friday 6 February 2026 with the classroom and storeroom open for use on Monday 9 February 2026.

NSW Health advises that mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.
