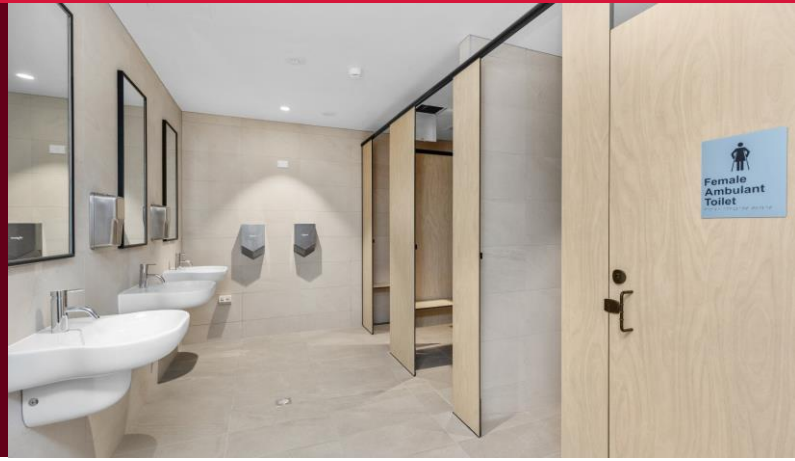


Barnier Public School Project update | March 2025



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment, Barnier Public School received a full refurbishment to the boys' and girls' toilets in Building G.

This work included repainting the walls and replacing the floor tiles, sinks, taps, soap dispensers, toilet paper dispensers, urinals, toilets and partitions.

This project was completed and handed over to the school in February 2025.

Other works at Barnier Public School

In addition to the toilet refurbishment, Barnier Public School is receiving an upgrade to other key school facilities, including:

- Re-coating the sports court with a new acrylic surface. This project was finished and handed over to the school in February 2025.
- A full refurbishment of Building I, including removing and replacing wall and ceiling linings, cabinetry, lights, electrical fittings and floor coverings. These works are currently underway and expected to be finished by 30 June 2025.
