## Works notification | 14 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Liverpool City Council is completing remediation work in Pye Hill Reserve following the discovery of bonded asbestos in the soil. For more information on this work please visit the [Liverpool City Council website](#).

On Friday 10 October 2025, the NSW Department of Education was notified by Liverpool City Council that a small amount of soil suspected to contain bonded asbestos was located just inside the school boundary fence of Cecil Hills Public School.

The soil was located on the southern and eastern fence lines, near Pye Hill Reserve.

As a precaution, on Saturday 11 October 2025, a licensed asbestos contractor removed the soil from the school site following the guidance of independent hygienists.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours, during the Spring School Holidays.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done.

The area was inspected by the independent hygienist on Monday 13 October 2025 who advised the area could be reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
