

Cecil Hills Public School

Works notification | 20 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the [works notification](#) we published on Tuesday 14 October 2025, the fragments of suspected bonded asbestos that were found in the soil just inside the boundary fence of Cecil Hills Public School have tested negative. This means that these fragments were not asbestos, and no remediation of this area is required.

Further to Liverpool City Council's remediation work in Pye Hill Reserve following the discovery of bonded asbestos in the soil, we have been undertaking broader searches of the grounds of Cecil Hills Public School as a precautionary measure. During these searches on Wednesday 15 October 2025 and Thursday 16 October 2025, small fragments of bonded asbestos were found in the ground around Building I. This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). Tests have confirmed that these fragments are bonded asbestos, and they were immediately removed from the school site by a licensed asbestos contractor, following the guidance of independent hygienists.

The register will be updated to include this recent find as required.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done.

The area was inspected by the independent hygienist on Wednesday 15 October 2025 who issued a clearance certificate and advised the area could be reopened. Further soil inspections will take place in due course, and we will keep the community updated as required.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
