## Woongarrah Public School Works notification | 7 May 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As part of school improvements, the department is continuing improvement works at Woongarrah Public School. This includes the installation of a new shade structure over the existing playground. This work is scheduled to begin on Monday 12 May 2025.

The shade structure construction site will be fenced off from 6 May 2025. This area is highlighted in yellow in the location map provided below.



## New shade structure installation and construction conditions

During the works, there may be some construction noise as there will be heavy machinery, including cranes, concrete trucks, and steel delivery vehicles accessing the school. As such, some noise and disruption can be expected throughout the construction period.

During this time there will be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements in nearby streets. All construction vehicles will access the construction site via the designated entrance on Mataram Road.

There will be no changes to student drop off zones and staff car parking at the school will not be affected.

Contractors will have noise and dust mitigation measures in place and will monitor levels throughout the construction period. Noisy works will be conducted outside of school hours as much as possible to minimise any disruption to the school and surrounding community.

Construction is due to be completed by early July 2025.
