

# Ropes Crossing Public School

## Works notification | 21 May 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Monday 18 May 2026, mould was found on the carpet in a demountable classroom building at Ropes Crossing Public School.

As a precaution, access to the classroom were restricted until an environmental clean took place on Wednesday 20 May 2026.

Teaching and learning activities were successfully relocated to ensure continuity of education with minimal disruption to students and staff.

All work involving mould was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work was completed by experienced contractors.

NSW Health advises that mould spores are present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and mould is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.
