Works notification | 9 December 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

A staff member reported suspected mould after low shelving units were moved in the Tullimbar Public School Building D library on Wednesday 4 December.

The library was made out of bounds on Thursday 5 December and students are learning from alternative classrooms.

An independent hygienist took samples from the room and conducted an inspection on Friday 6 December 2024.

Cleaning of the affected area and removal of damaged carpet has been completed. We are currently investigating the cause of the moisture build up.

Dehumidifiers are being sourced and all windows in the library have been opened to ventilate the room.

Once cleaning is complete a moisture test will be undertaken, and new carpet will be installed.

All work involving mould will take place during and outside school hours with appropriate safety measures in place.

Use and access to the library will be restricted until the area is fully remediated and the hygienist advises the room can be reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep you updated
