Marie Bashir Public School Works notification | 21 June 2024



Dear staff, parents and carers,

On 4 June 2024, after heavy rainfall, we noticed a damaged eave sheet in an undercover walkway between buildings B and C at Marie Bashir Public School.

The damage has not affected learning and teaching, however in preparation for repair work, the area was isolated with temporary fencing today, Friday 21 June 2024.

As an added precaution, we are treating the eave sheet as asbestos-containing material and have engaged an independent hygienist. Work to replace the ceiling sheet and remediate the area will be done on Saturday 22 June 2024.

All work will be done outside of school hours, in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is underway. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The walkway will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
