Works notification | 23 July 2024

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Recent weather conditions have resulted in excessive amounts of water flowing through and around the school site.

On Monday 15 July, during work to improve the stormwater drainage system, a cable connected to the electricity supply mains at Marie Bashir Public School was damaged, causing a power outage throughout the school. Power supply to neighbouring properties was not affected.

The incident was immediately reported to Ausgrid who disconnected the mains to turn off power supply. A backup generator was installed to continue electricity supply to the school and a sound barrier installed to minimise noise from the generator.

We are working with Ausgrid to replace the damaged cable and permanently restore electricity supply. We will continue to keep you updated about the progress of this work.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
