

Beauty Point Public School

Works notification | 2 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Following the notification on [8 August 2025](#), we wish to update you on the schedule of works to install a new boundary fence in some sections along the north boundary and a small section of the north-west corner near Government Road at Beauty Point Public School.

The NSW Department of Education can fence off school properties as indicated in the [Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 \(ILP Act\)](#). Beauty Point Public School is 'inclosed land' for the purposes of the ILP Act.

By securing the gates and restricting access, we will be providing greater safety and security for our students, staff and the wider community.

Work to install the fence will start on Monday 8 September 2025 and is expected to be finished by the end of October. Weather permitting, work hours will be between 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

Works involve:

- sections of the existing mesh fence on school grounds will be removed, and we will be installing new open tubular black steel security fence with a spear top along the north side of the school, set back from the shared boundary line
- referring to the map below, the new fence will run to the end of the brick wall (known as Kindy Cola) and pick up again at the end of Building J and continue to run behind the sensory playground. The new fence will be positioned back from the existing shared fence line, on the school grounds, allowing maintenance access
- a new gate will be installed in the north-east corner, near Government Road, and will open inwards onto school grounds. This work will include gate stoppers to prevent the gate from swinging outwards
- electronic access gate will be installed at the front of the school along Pursell Avenue
- permanent closed-circuit TV (CCTV) camera will be installed above one new Electronic Access Controlled (EAC) pedestrian gate on Pursell Avenue. The purpose of these cameras is to monitor entry into the school premises and add a level of security for students and staff.
